We like to remind all teams that they should dealt on players identity on the pitch and the Committee will only be dealt with cases that fail to be handled on the pitch and with visual aids sent.

U21 player movement move

This is the second year for the U21 players movement rule to be implemented. We are happy to see the young hockey players are improving with more exposures. However, we find that some clubs are using the loophole from the rule to maximise their own interest. The aim of the rule is to give young players more exposure in playing in higher level hockey. Meanwhile, some clubs deliberately register the young players in the lower ranked team to gain results. The incoming Committee will review the Competition Bye-law to stop the scenario.

B) Test Matches Series vs Singapore

Two test matches were played between Hong Kong, China and Singapore 24-26 October 2024. We lost both games to Singapore by 1-3.

This was the first international matches after Mr Arif Ali became the head coach of the squad. It is a good opportunity for the squad to understand their weakness from the tournament and work for improvement.
